

SAFETY FIRST!!!

Spectacular Fireworks USA is devoted in selling safe fireworks approved by the Consumer Product Safety Commission. We want you to feel safe, comfortable and extend to your family and friends the best fireworks ever. We ask that you use common sense and take your time when shooting your event. This will keep the American Tradition alive offering excitement, enjoyment and fun for everyone!

- 1.) DO NOT STORE OR USE FIREWORKS IN THE SAME LOCATION WITH FLAMMABLE MATERIAL.
- 2.) STORE FIREWORKS IN A SAFE LOCKED AREA AWAY FROM CHILDREN UNTIL USING THEM.
- 3.) PRIOR TO YOUR DISPLAY UNDERSTAND WHAT YOU HAVE PURCHASED AND HOW TO FIRE THE ITEM OFF.
- 4.) ALWAYS SECURE, BRACE ALL FIREWORK DEVICES FROM TIPPING OVER. EVEN THOUGH THE ITEMS LAY FLAT, TAKE THE TIME TO SECURE THEM. USE SAND, DIRT, ROCKS AND MAKE SURE THE GROUND OR BASE IS SOLID. PRESSURE FORCES DOWNWARD AND A SOLID BASE IS NEEDED.
- 5.) PLAY IT SAFE AND KEEP A SAFE DISTANCE FROM YOUR AUDIENCE. A MINIMUM OF 75 PLUS FEET FOR ALL FOUNTAIN AND REPEATING CAKE ITEMS. WHEN USING MORTAR TUBES A SAFE MINIMUM DISTANCE OF 150 FT. IS REQUIRED.
- 6.) ALWAYS CHECK THE WEATHER AND ACCOUNT FOR THE WIND. HAVE A SAFE FALLOUT AREA FOR ROCKETS, MORTARS, REPEATERS, Etc. TO PREVENT ANY FIRES.
- 7.) BEFORE LIGHTING ANY FIREWORKS, MAKE SURE YOU HAVE A BUCKET OF WATER OR WATERHOSE NEARBY TO EXTINGUISH ANY UNFORESEEN PROBLEMS.
- 8.) ALWAYS USE SAFETY GLASSES TO PROTECT YOUR EYES.
- 9.) NEVER PLACE ANY PART OF YOUR BODY DIRECTLY OVER THE FIREWORK DEVICE. BEND DOWN TO LIGHT THE ITEM, EXTENDING YOUR ARM TOWARD THE FUSE WITH A LIGHTING INSTRUMENT. WHEN THE FUSE IS BURNING MOVE QUICKLY TO A SAFE AREA TO WATCH THE FIREWORK PERFORM.
- 10.) NEVER TRY TO RE-LIGHT THE ITEM IF THERE IS A PROBLEM WITH THE FUSE.
- 11.) NEVER HOLD ROCKETS OR ROMAN CANDLES OR ANY FIREWORK ITEMS IN YOUR HANDS.
- 12.) WHEN USING ANY TYPE OF MORTAR KITS (RELOADABLES), ALWAYS UNTIE ALL FUSES PRIOR TO YOUR SHOW. UNDERSTAND HOW THEY ARE INSERTED IN THE TUBE. MAKE SURE THE TUBE IS SECURED IN A BUCKET OF SAND OR ON THE GROUND. FOLLOW ALL DIRECTIONS ON THE MORTAR TUBE BOX.
- 13.) WHENEVER YOU ARE UNSURE OF A FIREWORK DEVICE, ALWAYS CALL A PROFESSIONAL. REMEMBER: THERE IS NEVER A DUMB QUESTION.
